KU Undergraduate Biology is now accepting applications from undergraduate biology students seeking financial assistance for off-campus travel as an extension of their research efforts.



The Howieson Opportunity Fund has been established to assist undergraduate students who wish to travel to off-campus research laboratories, field research sites, or academic/scientific conferences. Priority is given to applications which include active research and/or intent to present papers/posters. Eligible applicants include all undergraduate students conducting research in the biological sciences at the University of Kansas. Monies from the fund are not designed to cover all of the costs associated with travel, etc., but to serve in conjunction with other resources. Proposals requesting up to \$500 will be considered; however, final determinations will be based on the quality/quantity of submissions and documented need.
